A KITCHEN CRAFTED AS FURNITURE

Hoelgaard is a tribute to the classical piece of furniture, crafted with the cabinetmaker's precision and the architect's eye for proportion. A kitchen where depth, rhythm and material understanding meet in a calm, graphic expression. The small opening in the centre rail serves as a handle and as a quiet claim on the attention: a detail that unites function and aesthetics with understated authority.

The drawers are finger-jointed and set within a cabinet where each one is framed with precision.

Designed for the room

Every solution begins with the room: the architecture, the light and the daily movements within the home. The process develops in close dialogue with the client and architect, resulting in a design proposal tailored to the specific space.

Depth, length and height are adapted to the proportions and architecture of the room. For projects that require it, the Signature Collection is supplemented with bespoke elements.

Made to measure

No piece of furniture from Garde Hvalsøe is based on standard modules. Each section is made to the measurements of the specific room, with the specific dimensions.

This is not adaptation. It is cabinetmaking that begins with the conditions of the room itself.





Hoelgaard solution: price example

This example shows a complete solution designed for a classic period villa: kitchen island, full-height cabinets and built-in bench.

The solution is executed in oak with a worktop in jadore quartzite. The full-height cabinets are configured for integrated appliances and storage, with internal drawers in solid timber and painted fronts. All furniture is made at our workshop in Denmark.

Dimensions in this example:

- Drawers width: 697 mm (2' 3")
- Worktop height: 910 mm (2' 11 $\frac{1}{2}$ ")
- Kitchen island: 1700 × 2270 mm (5' 7" × 7' 5")
- Tall cabinets: 4 sections

Total price 712.940,00 DKK excl. VAT

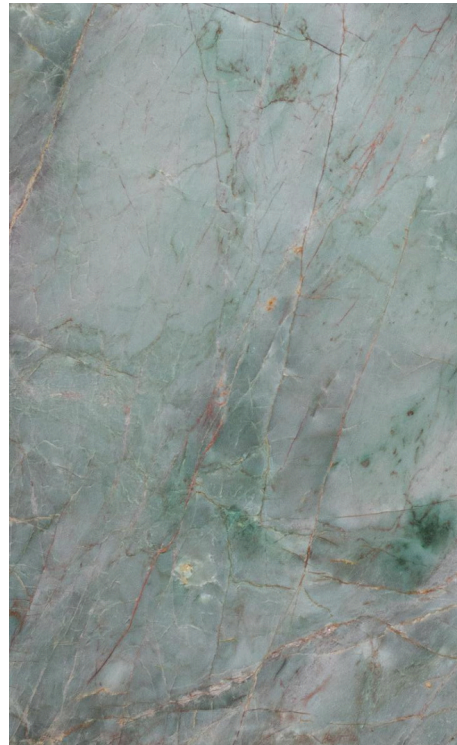
Excl. appliances, delivery and installation. Note: shelving unit not included.

The final price is determined for each individual project and reflects materials, dimensions and the architectural conditions of the room. This example indicates the level of investment for a comparable solution.

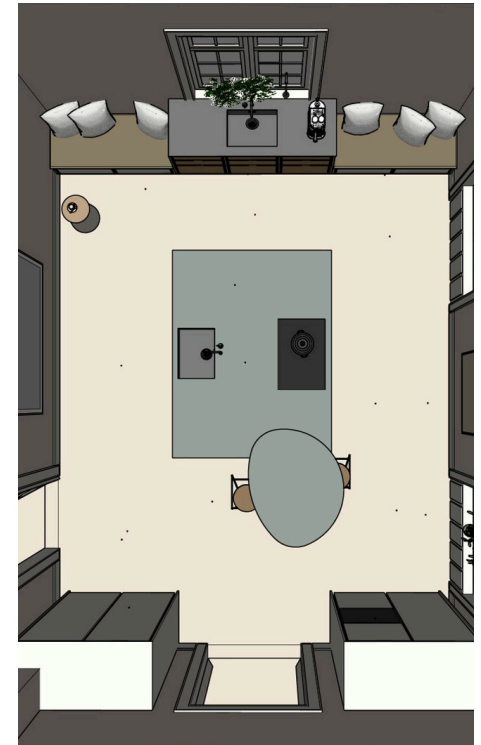

The process

Every project begins with a conversation about space, movement and architectural intention. Not about standards.

Design proposal

In collaboration with client and architect, a design proposal is developed covering materials, proportions and function. For selected projects, visualisations are produced so the solution can be assessed within its architectural context before going into production.



Technical drawings and production

Our technical studio produces detailed drawings and installation specifications. We measure on site and advise contractors and tradespeople on the placement of installations.

All furniture is made at our workshop in Denmark. We collaborate with specialist workshops in stone, upholstery, leather and metalwork.



Delivery and installation

All furniture is inspected and quality-assured before leaving the workshop. Delivery and installation are carried out by our own team.



Handover and service

When the project is complete, we walk through the solution together. Twelve months after delivery, a complimentary service visit is offered, during which the furniture is reviewed and adjusted as needed.

We also offer an ongoing service agreement. The purpose is to ensure the furniture retains its function and precision, and that the materials are allowed to develop the patina that comes with time.

A defined direction

The Signature Collection is built around three design expressions: Solid, Hoelgaard and Layer. Each expression represents a distinct design logic rooted in proportion, material and construction.

Proportions and dimensions are adapted in harmony with the rhythm of the furniture and the architecture of the room. The solution can be supplemented with bespoke elements developed specifically for the project.

Drawings and visualisations are produced in-house. We support the architect and other project partners with the necessary information throughout the process.

An expression of substance. Rooted in cabinetmaking.
